

TubeGuard

The TubeGuard is a device that secures an endotracheal tube and also serves as a bite block. The TubeGuard is an all in 1 ergonomic device that:

- 1) Secures the Endotracheal Tube to the patient
- 2) Serves as a bite block to prevent ETT occlusion
- 3) Protects the oropharyngeal soft tissue and teeth from injury
- 4) Fits all standard adult ETTs (6.0-8.0mm I.D.)
- 5) Eliminates need for tape/adhesives



The TubeGuard's main body is composed of soft, medical grade silicone, ensuring an atraumatic and comfortable interface with the patient's mouth and face. The device's clamp is constructed from durable glass-filled nylon and engineered to fit all adult endotracheal tubes (sizes 6.0-8.0mm I.D.). The TubeGuard surrounds the in situ endotracheal tube, locking it onto the maxilla and mandible through its contact with the teeth and gums. A Velcro neck strap adds an extra layer of security, ensuring maximal control of endotracheal tube position

The TubeGuard is the new Gold Standard for endotracheal security. A recently published peer-reviewed clinical trial demonstrated that the TubeGuard was superior to all forms of adhesive tape as a method to secure the endotracheal tube in numerous surgical settings. TubeGuard dramatically reduced unwanted endotracheal tube motion and eliminated the risk of accidental extubation. TubeGuard is ideal in settings that are typically difficult to secure an endotracheal tube, such as: 1) large beards/facial hair, 2) oily/weepy skin, 3) facial burns, 4) patient transport, 5) prone position, 6) cases with excessive head movement. Furthermore, the device is very useful in cases where small ETT movements would be detrimental (EMG tube for vocal cord monitoring, double lumen endobronchial tubes) and in patients undergoing intraoperative advanced neuro-monitoring (high risk for movement and biting).

The TubeGuard will protect your patient from injury to the lips, tongue, and teeth. Plus, the integrated bite-block eliminates the possibility of negative pressure pulmonary edema secondary to patient tube-biting. Finally, the TubeGuard's scientifically proven extreme resistance to dislodgement ensures that the endotracheal tube remains in the trachea and your patient remains safe.
